2019-2020 Registration Packet Due TODAY!

2019-2020 Registration Packets were sent home with your student(s). We ask all of our parents/guardians to complete the registration packet every year for the safety & well-being of the students. These forms are required by the Ohio Department of Education and our sponsor (ESCCO) to be updated annually or when there is a change in information regarding the student.

Please note: your student's enrollment at GEMS is not guaranteed for the 2019-20 school year until all necessary forms are returned. All forms are due today to secure your student's enrollment for the 2019-2020 school year.

In addition to the Registration Packet, we are mandated by the Ohio Department of Education to obtain a **new proof of residency** every school year. This can be a copy of a utility bill, lease agreement or mortgage statement. <u>Proof of residency must be submit-</u> ted on or before the first day of school. Utility bills must be dated on or after July 1, 2019.






GEMS Family Crew

Nurse Notes

Vaccination requirements for this school year:

- All incoming kindergarteners are required to have: DTap 4 or more doses, Polio 3 or more doses, MMR 2 doses, HEP B 3 doses, Varicella (Chicken Pox) 2 doses or a history of the disease.
- All incoming 7th and 8th graders will need a TDap and one dose of the Meningococcal vaccination (MCV4).

Please take time over the summer break to make sure your student is up to date in their vaccinations. Franklin County Public Health has free vaccination clinics. Ohio law states that GEMS must have valid immunization records prior to the 15th day of school or the student may be excluded from attending school until it is received

Attending school daily is critical to student success. Ohio's House Bill 410 law requires a preventative approach to excessive student absences. An Attendance Team has been established to work with students and families to help improve daily attendance.

Note* - Missing as few as 2 days per month is considered chronically absent! We want to see your studentin school every day!

RESIDENCY VERIFICATION NOTIFICATION

Per House Bill 21 community schools are now required to perform a monthly review of student files and randomly select families for residency verification. Please be sure to contact the school immediately in case of an address change. Proof of residency will need to be submitted within two weeks of an address change. If evidence is not provided requests for additional documentation or a home visit may occur.

GEMS is a School-wide Title 1 program, enabling us to receive Federal Funds to ensure that our students receive the support they need to reach and exceed grade level goals particularly in reading and math.
