Ohio State Tests - April 8-12

Ohio State Tests will be administered April 8-12. This administration is for students currently enrolled in Math I and II, American History, Biology, English, or Government *and* students who have previously taken any of the state tests but did not achieve a proficient score. Students are being prepared in their classes but should also prepare for the tests by going to <u>bit.ly/AIR-resources</u> and taking practice tests. It is very important that your student be familiar with what the online test look like and takes practice test so they can earn their graduation points.

Attendance for all days during the last week of the quarter, especially during state testing is vital to student success toward graduation. School hours are 8:00am-12:30pm for the week of April 8-12, busing will be provided for all students who typically ride the bus.

Food Deliveries Will Be Turned Away

Recently, TCS@ODU students have been having food delivered via services such as GrubHub, UberEats and DoorDash. These deliveries are disruptive to the school day and require strangers to enter our building, which is a safety risk. Although the administration has been talking to students to clarify that these deliveries are not permitted, some students continue to order food. Students are also not permitted to order or bring food from outside restaurants for other students. Per our Student-Family Handbook, "A parent who wishes to provide a lunch for the student instead of the one provided by TCS @ ODU is required to bring the lunch to the school office where the student will be called to obtain it during the student's lunch period." Food deliveries made to the school will be turned away, regardless of whether or not the delivery has already been paid for.

RESIDENCY VERIFICATION NOTIFICATION

Per House Bill 21 community schools are now required to perform a monthly review of student files and randomly select families for residency verification.

Please be aware you could be randomly selected to provide proof of residency during one of the required monthly random selections. Proof of residency would need to be turned in to the school within two weeks of the request. The following documents would satisfy the needs of the residency verification:

- A deed, mortgage, lease, current home owner's or renter's insurance declaration page, or current real property tax bill.
- A utility bill or receipt of utility installation issued within the last 90 days.
- A paycheck or paystub issued to the parent or student within the last 90 days that includes the address of the parent's or student's primary residence.
- The most current available bank statement issued to parent or student that includes the address of the parent's or student's primary residence.
- Any other official document issued to the parent or student that includes the address of the parent's or student's primary residence.

IF EVIDENCE IS NOT PROVIDED REQUESTS FOR ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION OR A HOME VISIT MAY OCCUR.

What do you know about Vaping or Juuling?

Because most schools, including our own, are seeing an increased use of e-cigarettes, virtually unknown just 7 years ago, we want parents and guardians to be well-informed on the subject.

In September 2018 the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) launched a new public health education campaign, "The Real Cost" Youth E-Cigarette Prevention Campaign. High school students are either susceptible or already experimenting with ecigarettes, also referred to as "vaping" or "juuling." In 2017, just over 1 in 10 high school students used e-cigarettes; now it's 1 in 5. What's worse is that many teens do not think these products are harmful. Some aren't even aware that most e-cigarettes contain nicotine. The link below contains a fact sheet provided by the FDA and Scholastic Books in order to assist parents, guardians and teachers become familiar with the myths and risks of vaping. We encourage you to read it and discuss with your student.
