They engaged with students from around the country to discuss issues facing the world today and to promote youth voices and the youth vote. Students presented a workshop lesson to raise awareness of gun violence and police brutality to students from Buffalo and in a New York City high school. They also explored New York and attended a Broadway show called *What the Constitution Means to Me*.





RESIDENCY VERIFICATION NOTIFICATION

Per House Bill 21 community schools are now required to perform a monthly review of student files and randomly select families for residency verification.

Nurse Notes

As we come to the end of the school year, if your child has a prescription medication at the front desk, please make arrangements to pick it up by the last day of school. If they are not picked up, they will be disposed of.

Vaccination requirements for next year:

- All incoming 7th graders will need a TDap and one dose of the Meningococcal vaccination (MCV4).
- All students in grades 7-10 are required to have one dose of the Meningococcal vaccine (MCV4).
- All incoming 12th graders are required to have 2 doses of the Meningococcal vaccine (MCV4).

Owl Pellets in Biology

Mrs. Painter's biology classes took apart owl pellets. This is a great lab to show students some different pieces of an ecosystem. Owls swallow their prey whole, and regurgitate the fur and bones; the parts they can't digest. By looking at the pellets, identifying the bones and rebuilding the skeletons, we can determine the type of animal the owl is eating.
