Attendance is important!

Attending school daily is critical to student success. Ohio's new House Bill 410 law requires a preventative approach to excessive student absences. An Attendance Team has been established to work with our students and families to help improve daily attendance.

Note* - Missing as few as 2 days per month is considered chronically absent! We want to see your student in school every day!

Nurse Notes:

With the cold season still in full swing, just a reminder that students are **NOT** to be carrying any prescription **OR** over the counter medication with them during the school day. We have supplies at all schools, and if there is a specific medication needed, please have it given to the front desk staff for administration.

Vaccination Reminders:

- All incoming 7th graders are required to have a TDap vaccination and a MCV4 vaccination prior to entry in to the 7th grade.
- All incoming 12th graders are required to have 2 MCV4 vaccinations, unless the first dose was given **AFTER** the 16th birthday.
- Make sure to get these at your next doctors appointment and send in the updated records. These can be sent in at any time, no need to wait until the next school year.
