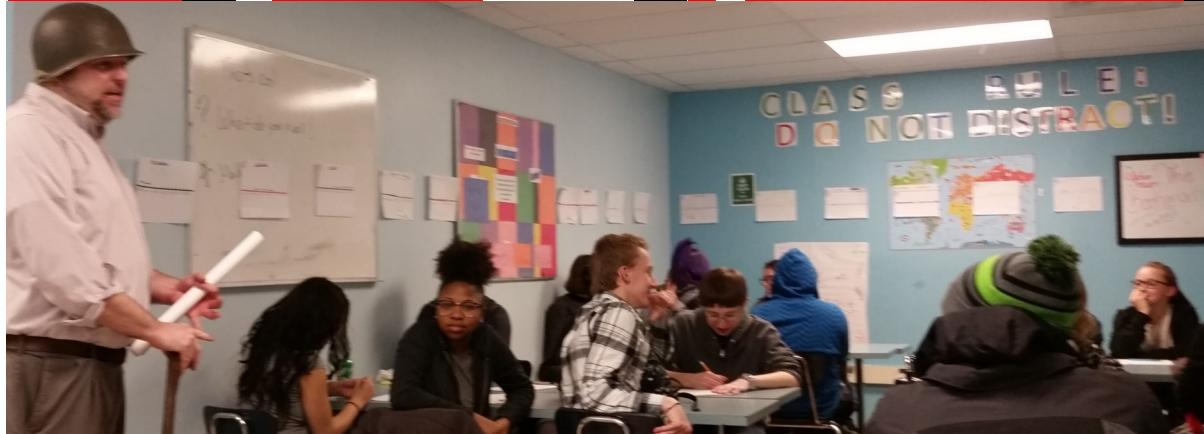

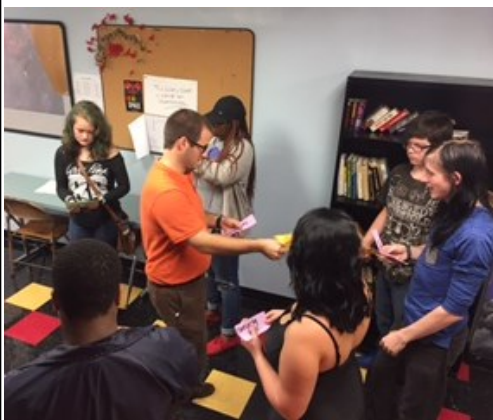

## Nurse Notes: Reminder on Immunizations

It is the law in Ohio that an immunization record be on file for each student. **If this has not been turned in for your child, please do so as soon as possible.**

### Specific Immunization Grade Requirements:

- All Incoming 7th Graders are required to have 1 TDap vaccination and 1 MCV4 vaccination.
- All 12th graders are required to have 2 doses of the MCV4 vaccination, unless the first one was given AFTER the 16th birthday.
- Fever Free for 24 hours before returning to school.
- Has not vomited in 24 hours, can return to school.
- Has taken any prescribed antibiotic for 24-48 hours, can return to school.
- All absences for medical reasons require a doctors note to be excused.

Please make sure that your student is in compliance with the required vaccinations. Cold weather brings more illness! Hand washing is very important to stop the spread of illness.

**Please make sure you are following the guidelines below for when your student is ill.**

Vision and Hearing screenings will be done before Christmas break for grades; K, 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 & 11. Letters will be sent home if any issues are found. Please follow up promptly with a specialist. Resources are available for vision exams and glasses, please ask the office staff for more information.
