## MAP Testing

The Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) testing is administered quarterly to all students. We use MAP testing to measure a student's growth in math and reading.

- Fall – September 4-7
- Winter – December 17-21
- Spring – April 29-May 3

## Ohio's State Tests

Ohio's State Tests (OST) state achievement tests. The state of Ohio requires that all students attempt the OST tests and receive a minimum number of 18 points from the seven tests.

- Fall – December 11-14
- Spring – April 15-19

## PSAT/NMSQT

Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) test is opportunity to practice for the SAT and ACT exams needed to get into colleges, as well as offering a way for the 11th grade students to sign up to receive scholarship information from colleges.

- Fall – October 24 (all 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> graders are required to take the PSAT/NMSQT)

## PSAT 8/9

The PSAT 8/9 test establishes a starting point in terms of college and career readiness as students enter in to high school.

- Fall – October 24 (all 9<sup>th</sup> graders are required to take the PSAT 8/9)

## SAT

The SAT is an entrance exam used by most colleges and universities to make admissions decisions. The state of Ohio requires that all 11th grade students take the SAT in the spring.

- Spring - March 6
